The Limited Public Hearing on the appeal of the approval of the application of Kemper Development Company for a CUP was held and closed on November 16, 2009 and was remanded to the Hearing Examiner for clarification. The Hearing Examiner held the remand hearing on January 21, 2010 and on February 4, 2010. Continued Council discussion was held and closed on July 26, 2010 and was remanded to the Hearing Examiner for additional evidence. The second remand hearing was held on August 25, 2010 and a second revised and final recommendation to Council was issued on December 16, 2010.

Due to scheduling difficulties we are now ready to proceed with continued Council discussion on this matter on **Monday, April 25, 2011**. The meeting will commence at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Bellevue City Hall, 450 - 110th Avenue NE. At the meeting, City Councilmembers may pose questions of the parties, but the City Council will not take public comment on that matter at Oral Communications or during the continued discussion of this matter later on the agenda as the public hearing has been closed.

Under the City Council rules of procedure, written materials from the parties to the appeal will be accepted by the City Clerk if submitted by 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 20, 2011. New information (evidence) not contained in the record made before the Hearing Examiner may not be presented.
